I. Warning:

This equipment should be installed by a qualified individual.
This equipment should be used by only one person at a time, supervised by a qualified individual.
Using this equipment for purposes other than those originally intended is not allowed.

II. Recommendations:

- As shown in French Standard NF S 52-400 the following is recommended:
- keep these instructions for subsequent reference (inspection, maintenance, etc.).
 - periodically carry out predictive maintenance.
 - depending on how much it is used have the equipment serviced yearly or every few years.

III. Maintenance:

- A preliminary cleaning of the complete Mini-trampoline allows better viewing of the problems, if any (distortion, breakage, or corrosion).
- Check the tightness of the fixings.
- Check the condition of springs or elastics, bed, protection and its ties, pads and wheels.
- Any damaged or distorted piece should be replaced as soon as possible.

IV. Protection with loops assembly (on the jumping direction) - Figure 1:

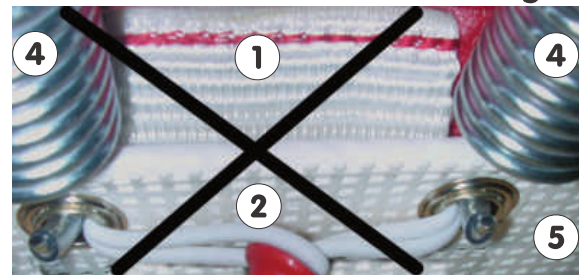
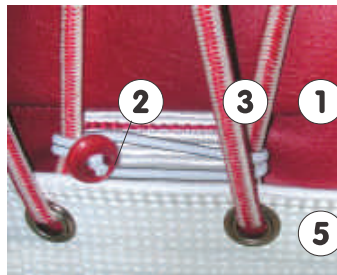
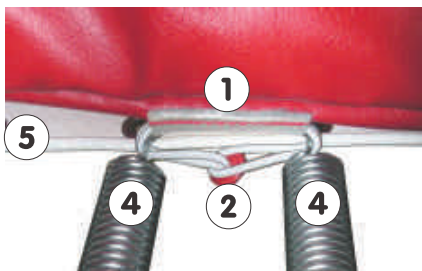
1. For mini-trampolines with "SPORTEX" bed (Ref.: 5000C & 5010C):

- Tie up the protection (1) with 4 elastows (2): either around 2 consecutive springs hooks like **Figure 2**, or around the elastics (3) like **Figure 3** and **not through bed eyelets** like **Figure 4**.
- Lock the 4 elastows (2) by threading the plastic button in the elastic loop.

2. For mini-trampolines with woven bed (Ref.: 5050C):

- Tie up the protection (1) with 4 elastows (2): around 2 consecutive springs (4) hooks like **Figure 5** and **not around bed (6) strips** like **Figure 6**.
